Vale Monty Russell

Monty Russell died recently. Monty was the founding chairman of the Co-operative. He was instrumental in the acquisition of Homeleigh and in instituting the renovations which have made it such a success.

Vale Bob Meadows

Bob Meadows died in early February. Bob was a member of VSA and also Rimstone from its inception. His other great interest was gold prospecting which he indulged in once he retired.

Scrubby Creek Property

The property was severely burnt in the 31st December 2020 bushfires. This has necessitated re-fencing the entire property. This has now been completed.

Rimstone was awarded an East Gippsland Catchment Management "Biodiversity Bushfire Recovery Grant" in November.

- This covers fencing for tufa terrace slopes area.
- Provision of a stock watering tank on the Western track side of the tufa terraces
- Construction of a track from the car park at the tufa terrace overlook down the slope to the cave and tufa terrace
- Planting of shade trees for the tufa terrace.

The fencing has been completed. The track construction is to make the track safer as it is slippery when wet or dry and there are several awkward steps. The track is to be minimalist rather than over-engineered.

Could someone come forward to manage the track construction project:
